## Minimising weed seeds of quarantine concern to China

The below tolerances to minimise the presence of weed seeds of quarantine concern to China in sorghum for consumption or processing for human consumption consignments have been sent to China and the department had no push back on these requirements. These tolerances do not apply to Sorghum for stockfeed.

The Authorised Officer is to use the tolerances when inspecting sorghum for consumption or processing for human consumption to meet China's phytosanitary import requirements.
