The dog(s) identified above has/have been vaccinated against canine distemper, canine adenovirus 2 (hepatitis), canine parainfluenza, and canine parvovirus, with vaccines licensed and approved for that purpose in Australia, as shown below. 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I, the undersigned official veterinarian⁽¹⁾/licensed veterinarian designated by the competent authority⁽¹⁾ of Australia certify that:

1. The dog(s) being presented for importation identified above was/were born in the kennel of origin and has/have resided there from the time of birth until the time of export to Canada.
2. The kennel of origin meets the following requirements:
 - a. The kennel of origin has an attending licensed veterinarian to ensure that adequate veterinary care is provided. There is a written program of veterinary care and a written health record for each dog in the kennel of origin. This program includes a basic preventative health care plan (e.g., regular examinations, vaccinations, deworming, etc.) and a schedule of regular visits by the attending veterinarian;
 - b. All dogs in the kennel of origin are uniquely identified by an approved means (tattoo or electronic microchip) and a log kept. The log includes the animal ID, the tombstone data relating to the dog and the final disposition of the dog. The data for each dog is retained for one year after the dog has left the kennel of origin;
 - c. The animal housing facilities in the kennel of origin are structurally sound and in good repair. The dogs are protected from injury and contained securely. Other animals, including wildlife, are restricted from entering. The dogs are provided with adequate space for their size, purpose and temperament. The dogs are kept in a humane manner;
 - d. The premises where the kennel of origin is located is free from accumulations of trash and waste materials, and maintained in a manner which prevents unhygienic conditions that may result in disease transmission. Good housekeeping practices are followed both inside and outside the kennel of origin;
 - e. In general, the kennel of origin is constructed in a manner and made of materials that allow it to be readily cleaned and sanitized, or be replaced when worn;
 - f. Interior surfaces that come into contact with dogs are free of rust, jagged edges or sharp points. Contact surfaces are cleaned daily to prevent the accumulation of excreta and reduce other disease hazards;
 - g. Floors made of dirt, absorbent bedding, sand, gravel, grass or similar are raked and/or cleaned. Contaminated material is removed and replaced so that odors are prevented or eliminated, and to eliminate insects, pests and vermin infestations;
 - h. The kennel of origin has reliable electric power for carrying out general husbandry requirements;
 - i. The kennel of origin has an adequate supply of running potable water to meet both the dogs' drinking needs and the kennel's cleaning needs;
 - j. Supplies of food and bedding are stored in a manner that protects it from spoilage or contamination; AND
 - k. Removal of waste, garbage, and dead animals is done on a regular schedule and in an appropriate manner to minimize contamination, control vermin and pests, and to reduce disease risks.
